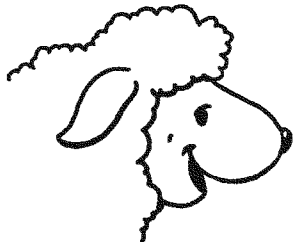

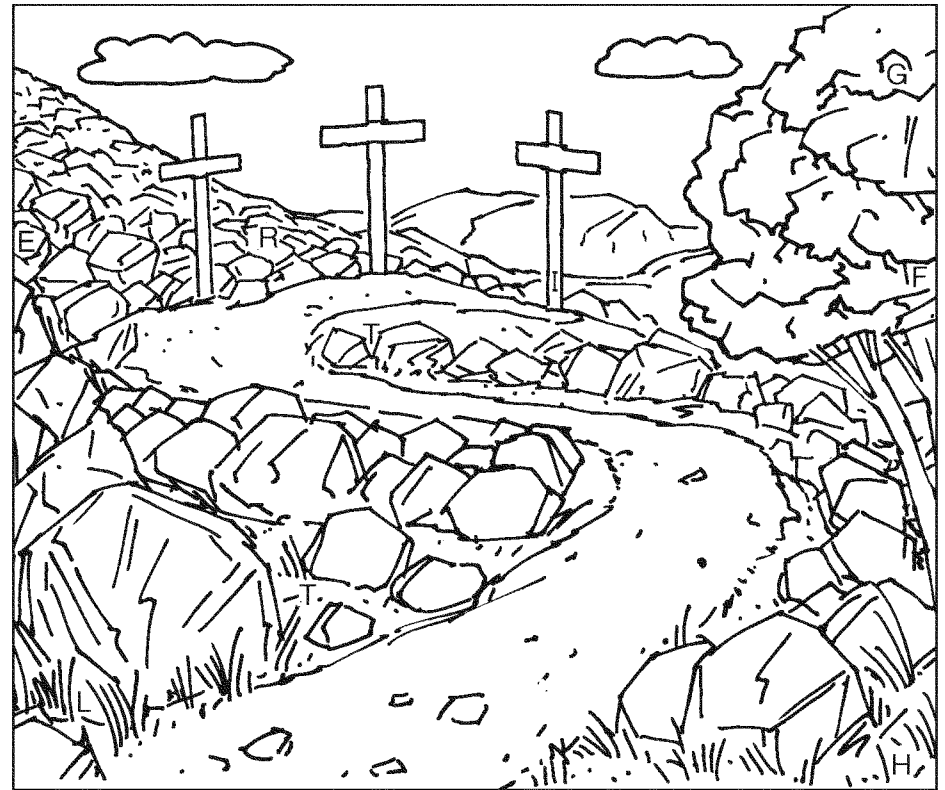

one on His right, the other on His left.

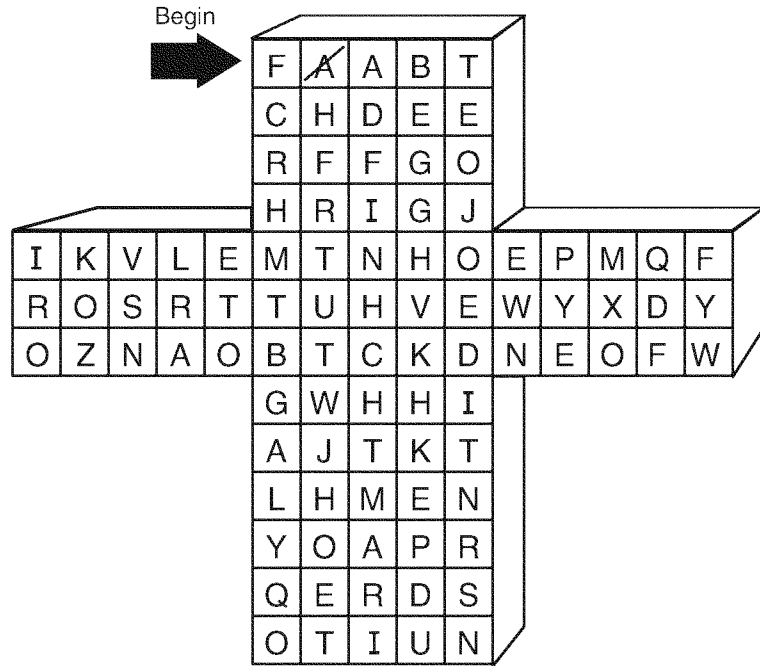
